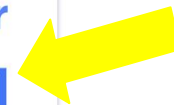

What is i-Ready?

i-Ready is an online program for reading and/or mathematics that will help your student's teacher(s) determine your student's opportunities for growth, personalize their learning, and monitor progress throughout the school year.

i-Ready Personalized Instruction Provides students with lessons based on their individual skill level and opportunities for improvement, so your student can learn at a pace that is just right for them. These lessons are fun and interactive to keep your student engaged as they learn.

How do I get my student started?

1. **My Path Lessons or Teacher-Assigned Lessons:** My Path lessons are assigned to your student based on their latest results on the i-Ready Diagnostic. Note that Teacher-Assigned Lessons will only appear as a choice on the screen if a teacher has manually assigned lessons.
2. **Learning Games:** These games help your student build mathematics skills in fun ways. To access the games, your student will need to choose Math in the upper left-hand corner of the To Do screen and then click on Learning Games in the bottom navigation bar.



Where can my student and I see the progress being made?



1. You and your student can monitor progress by clicking on My Progress in the bottom navigation bar. On the My Progress page, you will be able to see:
 - a. **Time-On-Task:** The number of minutes your student has spent this week (Monday– Sunday) on i-Ready Personalized Instruction
 - b. **Lessons Passed:** The total number of lessons your student has passed this school year
 - c. **Lesson Streak:** How many lessons your student has passed in a row
 - d. **Completed Work:** The name and quiz score for each lesson your student has taken
