 - This total includes partial amounts for Variety Show and Field Day Shirts
 - As a reminder, any money that surpasses the \$30,000 is disbursed based on school need. For example, excess funds have purchased a new sound system and speakers for school assemblies, replacing the Easter Bunny costume, new mulch for the playground, etc.
